

### PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



Happy New Year, Eagles FamilyWe're kicking off 2024 on a positive note and anticipating a purposeful school year ahead. This January, our focus is on encouraging students to set goals. Parents and guardians can connect goal setting with your child's school data, like the iReady Diagnostic 2 results on Parent Vue (PVue), to foster reflective learning and growth. Let's support and encourage our lifelong learners in setting and achieving goals for success!

#### **MacArthur Running Club Fridays**

Using ELOP funding, the Running Club enrichment program is on Fridays, before school, with Ms. Henry. This enrichment program focuses on ensuring our students are physically fit. Regular attendance is suggested but we will allow drop ins as long as we have permission slips on file. Please sign the permission slip using the QR code before dropping off your child on Fridays from 8:15 - 8:45 a.m.



#### **Student Safety**

Please make a commitment to arrive before or after school at least 5-10 minutes early and park on the school side of MacArthur so that our students continue to be safe. As a reminder: **our parking lot is for teachers and staff only.** Students may not be dropped off in our parking lot. Let's not wait for an accident to happen in order for us to remember this MacArthur rule.



Special instances where it is OK to park in our parking lot: school-wide events, assemblies, Citizen of the Month, movie nights, family picnic, family dance night, or any after hours PTA event.

Lakewood PD is aware of MacArthur's safety issues during drop offs and pickups. They will be issuing warnings and tickets for jaywalking, double parking, parking in the yellow loading zones, parking in the red zones, or parking in between the arrow signs (in front of our school).

- Please do not drop off students on the opposite side of the street.
- Children are not allowed to jaywalk, it is not safe for them to cross the street in between cars
- It is not safe to double park in the middle of the street, this causes a traffic backlog and it is extremely dangerous to ask your children to enter your car in the middle of the road.
- Refrain from honking... thanks!
- If you have to park in the neighborhood, please be mindful of our neighbors by not blocking their driveways.


