

Meet the Masters:


PTA funds MTM assemblies and classroom lessons each school year. Students focus on one artist each time and create an artwork inspired by that artist.

Every November, the MacArthur community comes together to help lower income individuals by donating necessary items to shelter or Food drive.




Student Incentives:


